Repairs. At the present time, new fore piece of keelson, an iron
 breasthook refastened with copper bolts, caulked and
 a general overhaul,
 sheathed with yellow metal over paper
 & along the deck fastenings and aloft - and saw
 the bottom which is firm and good.

General Observations This vessel caulked remarkably well and appears very firm
 and Opinion, as at her fastenings and in good condition both in the hull & stores
 required by the Instructions. I am of opinion she may remain in her present safe -
