**Repairs.** At the present time additional Iron Knees put to the Deck & Hold Beams and the Beams wedged - The new piece of keelson put in afloat last year, now properly bolted through all - Shelf and Watertown refastened, the Starboard bolts removed - the vessel caulked throughout and recoppered - Has undergone a general overhaul.

**General Observations and Opinion, as required by the Instructions** The Repairs now done under my notice will in my opinion render this vessel efficient for the safe conveyance of dry stowable Cargoes & entitle her to be classed A1
