Repairs. At the present time stripped 5 planks shifted under one Quarter
 & 2 under the other of one plank shifted forward in the upper
 course - Caulked from the keel up - 4 stakes wood sheathing
 put upon upper course & fitted - Bottom recapped -
 new Rudder -

General Observations and Opinion, as required by the Instructions
 The Transoms and Timbers exposed were quite
 sound and good - The Planks of the Bottom good
 In general appearance favorable throughout
 In my opinion is eligible to remain in
 her present class F. 1
