At the present time doubling from the 1st Futtock keels to the top of the gunwale with African Oak and all through fastenings - All the fastenings of both tiers of Beams renewed - 21 hipped Deck & 1 Woodbeam - Knees shifted - New Stern Post - New Spunkelling, New Shears, New Counter & New Rudder - New Rudder refitted - The hull thoroughly overhauled, and put into a most efficient state of repair - Masts, Yards and Rigging all overhauled - 3 hipped Deck Beams shifted. Lapped at the present time & wood sheathed from keel to doubtings -
