Repairs. At the present time stripped - Caulked from the keel up and thoroughly overhauled & recoppered -

Several of the in and out Bolts in brake of chain and two Rings driven out for examination and found to be remarkably free from corrosion and are in good condition - Several Remains driven out also for examination - perfectly sound & fresh - There is no appearance of movement about any of the Beam fastenings or the braceday beams - The Breast Hooks and Transoms are sound and free from motion. House timbers, Knightheads, Floor keelsons - Timbers of the Trams and outside Planking when they can be seen either inside or out are sound and good - The Sheer of the Ship is unaltered & the keel straight - Decks and coaming - all good and efficient -
