**Repairs.** *At the present time has been caulked from the mid up and recoppered having 2 Stakes of felt under the upper course*

General Observations and Opinion, as required by the Instructions

*The bottom of this ship has caulked very finely & has not presented any appearance of weakness. It is firm on deck at the waterway seams and beam ends. The bottom plank is generally shifted two between with 6 feet shift. Has 3 stakes of thicker stuff at the fore & aft outside. Both hull & materials are in an efficient and proper condition.*
