**Repairs** *At the present time shipped, caulked from keel  
 up over all - and recoppered upon Tell <sup>to the keel</sup>  
 and Quarter galleries. - Recommended that  
 over two pairs of Staple Standards should be  
 put in, in rake of Roofs - Green Decks - there being  
 some movement in that part. With this exception  
 she presents a very firm and substantial appearance  
 throughout her Lower Deck, & a Fore castle put on.*
