Prod. Laths & Coppered - The wood sheathing caulked  
The Butts of the Bottom lister. Scauphs of keel examined  
Ship Hull & keel seam caulked - Waler & Topside are  
to be caulked -

The lower part of the stem has been shifted in  
consequence of a leak having been discovered in it.  
The Bottom has caulked firm and well. her  
general appearance is favorable and in my  
opinion she should be classed A. 1
