 Keelson to nearly the Lower Deck (stump on both sides. an additional
 shelf to Hold Beams and New Planksheer - and at Quebec since a
 New keel - The above repairs have evidently been done within a
 very recent period & are efficient so far as they go -

 she will be well entitled to be classed E.1
