In the Months of Decr & Janr the Strakes through which the Chain bolts go were taken out the topsides Caulked and many pieces put in the ship generally overhauled in her upper works and decks

General Observations and Opinion, as required by the Instructions

The frame seen in shifting the Stakes proved very sound excepting two timbers the topsides ~~the~~ are becoming in places and will soon require shifting they are in my opinion sufficiently good for the present in other respects ^{the} condition is good and may be continued in her present class
