## Repairs

At the present time shipped - 1 new breast hook, all  
 repaired & refastened - 5 planks shifted in each quarter below  
 the wale & 8 forward - The planks in wake of  
 Chain Bots shifted - New knee of Head & false  
 stem about 4 stakes of Ceiling in each Bilge shifted  
 & some forward - 2 pair of additional Iron Ranging  
 knees to lower deck 1 pair at the Break, 3 broad  
 knees shifted caulked throughout the damage  
 thoroughly repaired & recoppered as before, all new  
 masts, Bowsprit, Yards, Riggings Hails - When opened  
 the timbers good and sound - the keel straight  
 & the Sheer unaltered
