## Repairs

At the present time, new large shelf under the hold beams bolted up & down through the beam ends & waterway and in and out through the side, being repaired with new quarter timber & stern & new stanchions. Some pieces of plank show some additional bolts in the knees sides & waterways &c caulked.

April 1. Some months since I was particularly requested to meet the owner or his representatives on board for the purpose of advising what repairs should be entered upon - I then gave the best advice in my power as to the course to be pursued - a part only of my recommendations has been adopted - George Barclay
