**Repairs** At the present time in consequence of  
 having been ashore shipped, 6 or long pieces  
 11 long Runners & 15 refters - & 4 or 5 beams  
 shifted - a brimble fitted on Port after  
 caulking from the keel up over all. Fitted  
 wood sheaths and all the damage repaired  
 repaired - The timbers exposed where  
 the beams were shifted are very good -
