## REPAIRS

At the present time 6 new Hold beams and 2 half do four Breast  
 Hooks refayed and rebotten, Some new planks in the doubling of  
 the wales, New Crutch aft Some new Ciding forward, New Apron,  
 Long portion of Hold beams refastened also the Riders, new  
 facing piece to them, Some of the Sheathing taken off the bottom  
 forward and aft. Caulked then refitted & sheathed

As before the wales & Breast Hooks only are doubled
