REPAIRS At the present time stopped - doubled from top of braces to the keel with East India Teak - Dautie for by American Elm. upon Sills all through fastened with Greenails & Bolts in a proper and secure manner - The Keelson, Stern, & Stern Post refastened with Copper - 2 Breast Hooks shifted. Deadwood knee & Hatch put in. nearly all new Ceiling (200 feet abt) in the hold a number of Fillings & additional Timbers put in where required - New & additional Shelf to the Upper and Lower Deck and all the Beams refastened - Part new Sheer Strakes, making the whole new within a few years (say since 1837). Caulked throughout galleries removed & refitted. thoroughly overhauled and the Sabs keel removed to examine the Scarphs of the Main keel
