REPAIRS At the present time, shifted part of Stacks & beams on both sides then took off the side on the Starboard bow and several Septimus shifted strake of deck next the waterways both sides. Beams ends and thence very good. Caulked from the Copper over all: fitted a key in the Ribson; Examined the upper & lower deck between the Stacks through which they pass: the waterways & beams. Shown timber Knight-heads Breaststroke and Transoms. The Stone Millstone. Planking outside from the Copper up the Ceiling inside, the beam and inner surface of the outside planking where it can be seen: take a Cummings, which are in good condition: The Hull is straight & her stern good.
