REPAIRS At the present time, and Wm. Thomas, quarter hinders & one
babin hinders; the afterboards of the Black strokes, Wale & bows
strokes on the upper cases of the bottom & tipped, the lower stroke
of the Wale shifted in both sides and part of the rest, and all
the side beams fastenings renewed with Copper, and caulked;
Several keeneails put for examination & some of the fastenings
to the Deck beams, and found in good condition as well as the planks
through which they pass, the Waterways, Beams, Hatch beams
Breasthooks, Transoms, Stems, Helms, Planking outside and
inside, Frame when exposed, Decks & Coverings are all in a
very sound & efficient state, the Hull is straight and
has preserved her original shape & form —
