REPAIRS at the present time from damage of New Masts and  
Ratworks and some treenails in topsides — and from other  
causes after part of plank sheers and sheer strokes on both  
sides — many treenails in flat of bottom and the greater  
part of them in the topsides. New batts in upper  
and lower deck knees of the Beams — stripped coarshed  
and uoppend — The upper and lower deck batts the planks  
through which they pass, the waterways and beams, house timbers  
knights heads, breast hooks, transoms, the floors and keelsons  
the planking outside from the keel up (topside scraped)  
the culing and the inside surface of the outside plank when it  
could be seen the Decks and Comings all in good condition  
the keel is straight and the sheer unaltered
