## REPAIRS

at this time her bottom, wales, topsides & Decks have been Caulked her bottom recoppered on dry Paper - her topsides have been carefully overhauled and new Side Stern timbers fitted - her topmast & yards have been shortened The upper & lower deck bolt & the outside planks & ribs which they pass the waterways & beams so far as they can be examined they have timbers & through bolts breasthooks & transoms the floors & keelson planking outside from the keel upwards the Culling inside the frame & inner surface of the outside planking where it has been seen the deck and Coamings are all in good & sound condition the keel is straight & the sheer unaltered
