The upper and lower deck bolts and the outside planks through which they pass the waterways & beams so far as they have been seen and the house timbers knee-heads breasthooks and transoms the floors & Nelson planking from the Copper upwards the Ceiling inside the frame & inner surface of the outside planking where it was seen and the decks & Coamings are all in fair & good Condition Her Keel straight and Sheer unaltered
