REPAIRS Rep^d Yellow Metal

The yellow metal sheathing is smooth and good, and her appearance inside is very favorable upon the whole, and free from the appearance of straining upon her fastenings.

The repair done in 1838 appears to have been principally done with American Red & Yellow Pine - and the ceiling is a good deal bruised & disfigured below ~~with~~ by the Cargo or Cargoes of Mahogany.
