REPAIRS At Bombay on her last voyage the sheathing stripped off from the keel to the first footboard heads and a listing out out of the forward ends to examine the state of the caulking which proved to have been in a very sound state, was resheathed over Chanam in the flat & Copied over Chanam; At the present time bottom examined, and part of a plank stripped off at the turn of the bilge and found the caulking very hard & sound so much so as it was with difficulty a thread of Oakum could be put in, the upper & lower deck fastenings are in good condition, the waterways, beams, brass, timbers, knightheads, breasthooks, transoms, floors, beloms, plankings outside & inside, frame where seen, Decks & coverings are all in the very best condition, the keel is straight and has preserved her original form.
