at present Knee of Head taken down and new upper pieces of ~~head~~ stem and apron & both knightheads and the bottom house timber have been renewed - the hooding ends and part of wales & topsides ^{& deck} caulked - yellow metal patches and drips and new checks fitted to main mast and ship generally overhauled


