REPAIRS

at present (partly from damage) stripped hung 4000 beams  
 renewed a new lower breast hook of iron fastened over the  
 board put fitted, upper Clamps rebotted - bilge plank refastened  
 with about 70 Copper ( $\frac{3}{4}$ ) bolts - five additional lower deck  
 beams put in secured with 5 pairs hanging iron knees Copper  
 bolts - new Mast Parteners to Fore & Main Masts - new  
 to wood lap bolts - X transom knees rebotted one pair of addi-  
 tional knees to upper deck beam at the luff of the bows - Caulked  
 from the keel to the waterways and bottom casheathed with  
 yellow metal on felt - lower deck waterway rebotted  
 and throat bolts of the hanging knees of lower deck renewed
