REPAIRS at present the Copper Sheathing stripped off and not replaced  
the old iron bolts of hold riders renewed of iron. one pair  
of additional knee riders fitted forward and another pair  
fitted aft in the hold and a new iron Crutch to the keel  
of after Cauts one new breasthook under lower <sup>raft</sup> bow port  
now fitted of same Oak She has now been opened at the  
belys according to the Society's rules and the timbers  
exposed found sound except two on the larb side forward  
and three on the Starboard side aft - one piece of hog knee  
abast the step of the fore mast renewed - all the bands of the  
Rudder new of iron - Vessel Caulked from the keel to the  
gun hole and generally overhauled -
