REPAIRS This vessel has been stripped, hung in shores, caulked from keel to the upper edge of the wales. - the treenails have been renewed in the two upper strakes of wale and also the throat bolts of the upper deck hanging knees on the Starboard side and 6 of the throat bolts on the larboard side. - an additional pair of hanging knees to the fore beam of the main mast. New cheeks on the larboard side - new navel hoods both Starboard & Larboard - new front piece to the knee of the lead, ^{a pair of iron cheek bolting plates.} and generally the works of the lead ref'd - the bottom has been coppered over felt. She has had two new counter planks of teak and her lower deck has been caulked all over.
