REPAIRS At the present time 8 Iron hanging knees to hold beams part new sheathing in the flat of bottom, fittings cut and Hoodm was caulked, hood sheathing uncut, Water Buck strokes Waterways and two beams of the decks and sportings caulked, 50 feet of Decks shifted false keel refastened, Rudder pintals and braces rebolted
