## REPAIRS

Three pairs of Staple Standards have now been added, connecting the Deck and Hold Beams; also Caulked entirely above the Yellow Metal Sheathing.

She has been carefully examined, and the Timbers exposed in various parts, so as to admit air in future; all of which parts appear in firm condition, and is now purchased by the present Owners.

This Vessel was Reported by the Surveyors of this Society at Sunderland when built, recommended for BA1, but not Class'd; she stands in the Liverpool Registry BA1.
