 REPAIRS at present from damage stopped & hung. all new Hull except after
 piece and all new false keel & lower piece of girdle with new
 iron plates have been fitted - four planks of Starboard bely and
 three planks of Ceiling on Starboard bely shifted and both
 belys additionally Copper bolted with 48 bolts each Caulked
 all over including lower deck and bottom resheathed with yellow
 metal on paper - And in addition the whole of the keelsons
 which were of Amer oak and decayed have now been renewed
 of teak and eight pairs of iron riders have been fitted
 in the hold thro bolted with Copper - and the ship generally
 overhauled and refitted
