REPAIRS This ship has been surveyed for damage - and has consequently been stripped, hung, caulked, keel seam inclusive, to the gunwale and recovered with ym, over felt below a ^{top}booth doubling, and over tarred paper upon the doubling. She has had a new after piece of keel 9 ft long, and 16 1/2 feet of new false keel. She has also had 48 additional dump bolts 9 ⁱⁿ long into the bottom from the turn of the bidge downwards - 12 ym bolts as additional middle line fastening through the keelson, and 16 ym bolts as additional middle line fastening through the Jook - and the iron fastening of the breasthook has been driven out & renewed with ym.
