REPAIRS

From internal examination we are of opinion that the bottom Planks of this Vessel are fastened with Iron ~~and~~ thro' bottles at the butts with Copper - And as she has Lapped the Prescribed age (as per Sect 70) for Indian built vessel so fastened remaining without either Copper and treenail fastening or doubling the bottom the owner has been requested to do - She appears very firm on her fastenings and generally in good Condition the Ceiling of the hold is badly shifted but this would be of less consequence if the was doubled
