REPAIRS Channels taken off and the bolts shifted into fresh wood, two planks shifted in the sheer stake with scab - several bolts & treenails driven out and the planking scraped bright from the plank to sheer to the copper for examination which are in a sound state, the plank sheer, waterways, beams, house timbers, knight head, breasthooks, transoms, floors, keelson, decks and comings ceiling are all in a very healthy good condition the keel is straight and her sheer appears in its original form -
