REPAIRS now done of damages sustained by striking the ground, and heavy Sea in her passage from South America to London. The Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off and replaced, the Ship hung and Caulked from Wale upwards and from Wale to Keel; The Foremost and the Aftermost Pieces of False Keel renewed and the remainder refastened; Eleven Stantions and a Timber Head new, the whole of the Bulwarks and Rails betwixt the Poop and Forecastle renewed; the Deck repaired where necessary.
