At Present time Seven after hoods on her Starboard
buttock and eight on the Lizardboard have been removed
and the Starboard half of the King transom has been
renewed and a new fore transom and upper piece
of Stern Post have been fitted to her and the transom
rebolted thro' the doubling - Her bottom has been
stripped and Caulked and New foot top Sheathing
wrought (below the fourth strake of doubling that ^{is upper} ~~has been~~
the lower edge of the (Wales) on fore and her bottom is capped
on tarred paper - During the progress of this repair the
butt of the old bottom particularly forward and the
hooding ends at the Stern were found very wide and
were furred up - Notice in writing was given to the
Carpenter to fit a Pair of Sorenters to her Stern frame which
they declined doing at present for want of time but promised
they should be fitted in next voyage
