REPAIRS *Bottom examined having been in shore in her last voyage from*  
*examined the caulking of the Bul beam & flat of the bottom which proved*  
*very good, new head and cutwater, new Planks, and Mouldings &*  
*caulked from the Stoppers to the waterway beam.*  
*The sheer shakes and wales sawed bright several b.p.s. & thenails*  
*run out and found in good condition as well as the planks through which*  
*they pass; the waterways, beams, house timbers, knightrails, headboards*  
*transoms, floors & tridams, planking outside & inside, Decks and corners*  
*are all in a sound & efficient state, the keel is straight, her sheer*  
*appears in its original form—*
