REPAIRS In consequence of damage - bulwarks repaired and refitted, a piece of plank sheen about 16 ft long on the starboard side sheathed, some beams in the bottom renewed, the walls, ceiling, sheer strakes, and stanchions caulked. Also she has had her bottom stripped, caulked, and covered with gutta over dry paper - One new house bolted and new lower gips - the deck fastenings better examined and some renewed.
