at present bottom stripped one plank on the larboard bow shifted. two new foremost pieces of Nelson of American Oak timber exposed found sound and good - bottom wales & studding caulked, braced and bolts driven out found good - several pieces of deck plank shifted bottom sheathed with yellow metal on paper - New fore & main yard furnished
