REPAIRS of Damage - has had 5 new Ruyter's Stations, and about 30 ft of Ruyter's  
 rails below the bulwarks, and good new - the rails, fitting, and bolting of the head repairs -  
 one hanging knee to deck beam taken down passed through the pier & rebolter - the deck and  
 waterway on the starboard side additionally fastened, and the ship's ribs caulked from the  
 keel up and over to the third beam of the deck - three bolts of third beam hang's knee etc.  
 The Bottom has been seen in dry dock
