REPAIRS Has been stripped and caulked from keel to the wales. The treenails in the upper course of the bottom renewed - one iron breast hook unbolted and rebolted, two new wood breast-hooks - a new lower transom - 4 new stanchions to hold beams - some through bolts of hold beams hanging knees renewed with copper - larboard haue pipe has been taken out and refitted - and the windluffs and Winch unshipped and refitted - the bottom sheathed with yellow metal over paper below and felt on the upper course.
