REPAIRS now done. The Copper Sheathing stripped off and not renewed, Wales Topsides and Sheer Strake scraped bright: 43 Feet of Sheer Strake aft Midship, and 42 Feet of Topside Plank on each side in way of Fore and Main Chain Bolts renewed with American Oak: The Treennails extending from abeam of Fore to Main Masts and from Gunwales to Bilges replaced with new; the Ship being up in her Sheer on the Starboard side two Ceiling Planks have been replaced to examine Timbers: two Pairs of Iron Rides extending from Upper Deck Clamp across Bilges and two Pairs of Knee Rides from Hold Beams D^o - have been introduced and through Bolts with Iron.
