REPAIRS at present. The Copper Sheathing stripped off, Ship  
 hung, Caulked throughout, and the Bottom Sheathed with  
 Yellow Metal upon Paper; Channels narrowed, all Chain work  
 new; Hold Ceiling wedged up Pieced and extra Fastened the whole  
 dubbed over and about 70 feet renewed; the Ceiling between Decks  
 well overhauled, Pieced and additionally fastened; Plank of Upper  
 and Lower Decks refastened; about 67 feet of Riding Keelson & brigs  
 thick replaced with new of 5 1/2 inches thick; Six Wood Hanging  
 knees to Hold Beams extra Bolted. The Treennails from in Doubling  
 from Lower edge of Wales to Bilges replaced.
