at present two breasthooks in hold taken down and
 new middle piece of Apron fitted and hook replaced
 all new deck between Main & Fore hatches and the
 Plank of deck next to Ways on both sides renewed
 four new half beams fitted on larboard side of upper
 deck and one new on Starboard side six new wood
 bolting knees on Starboard side & two on larboard
 side one new half to hold beam also two upper W-
 beams clamped - all new throat bolts & knees of
 both decks - topsides wales & sheerstrakes scraped
 bright & bottom & wales Caulked and bottom sheathed
 with Galvanised iron on felt - Ceiling rubbed bright
 and repaired
