REPAIRS now done, of damage by being on shore. The Copper sheathing stripped off. Hung in shores, Caulked from upper edge of Wales to keel the Bottom re-sheathed with Yellow Metal upon Paper, one new Hold Beam; a Deck Beam and three Hold Beams secured.

Pl<sup>d</sup> not of accident. The stake of Deck on each side (except a short after Hood) replaced with new, the vessel Caulked from Wales upwards over all. Windlass repaired and fitted with a Patent purchase.

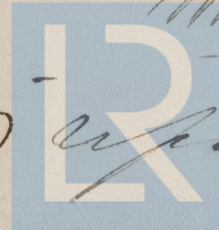
