REPAIRS at Present New Starboard Side Counter timber and one new Stern timber next it a Chock fitted on Starboard end of King transom and a new Iron fitted on end of transom three new afterhoods of wales and three afterhoods of sheerstrakes all afterhoods of topsides and Good Planking on Starboard Side - about 200 feet of upper deck shifted - Keelson dubbed over bottom strappes Caulked and Resheathed with Yellow Metal on felt
