REPAIRS *At the present time the planking of the poop and fore-castle taken down and those parts additionally timbered with English Oak and uplanked with E.I. Teak. The topsides doubled with 2 1/2 inch E.I. Teak properly bolted with felt under moor, new planks. There are additional bolts to upper deck knees new chain bolts Head repaired, being repaired.*
