at present bottom stripped. Caulked from Keel to gunwale upper Courses examined throat bolts of lower deck hanging knees renewed and many new in lower shelf - treenails renewed in wales and blackstrakes. bolts renewed in upper hook one new head check new larboard house pipe several new chain bolts. Sheerstrakes pieced - 5 new boughten stanchions and after piece of boughten tail new - two new planks fitted in Counter galleries off & refitted Ceiling repaired -
