REPAIRS at present New fore piece of Kelson fitted of African oak and Middle piece of Main Kelson trimmed down and two lengths of new hog Kelson fitted of African oak from Main Ship forward. Wals topsides and Sheerstrakes scraped bright trimmings and bolts driven out for Curvey found sound & good. Caulked from Y Metal to Waterways. Rudder overhauled and bands refastened. Yellow Metal which is smooth is patched and scraped. All the requisitions of the Rule Sect 60 & 54 have been complied with.
