REPAIRS at Present from Damage - Wood & Copper Sheathing ~~off~~ off Viper hung in Shores New fore piece of false keel fitted bottom ^{caulked} fitted and new wood sheathed to the wales and treenailed with yellow metal - wales topside sheathed and deck caulked one new wooden breasthook fitted in hold and two others refitted - 9 new wrought iron stanchions on each side and new rail and balustrade on both sides - bulkhead of poop refitted with four new Cants - new Comings to main ~~upper~~ hatch new shafts ceiling in hold forward - Hull masts and rigging generally overhauled & refitted
