REPAIRS at the present time in complying with Special Survey for Continuation Rule Section No. 54.

The outside Planking from Yellow Metal upwards scraped bright. Bolts and Treennails driven out at various parts for examination. On the Larboard side the whole of Plank sheer, three Strake, and a Fore Flood of Spinketting new, also several Fittings placed in wide spaces between Top Timbers, and where the Timbers were short, all of English Oak.

The upper Deck, Coamings, Deck Fastening Bolts Inside and Outside Planking, Treennails, Plank sheer, Waterway, Beams, Knees, House Timbers, Wright heads, Breast hooks, Keels and Transoms, Floors and Timbers of the Frame where they may be seen, have been examined by us, and are in good condition. The Keel is straight and her original Form appears preserved unaltered.
