REPAIRS at the present time. From damage by accident. viz the whole of main keel and the Gripe new. The Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off and removed upon Telt. Caulked from upper part of Wale to keel, two Planks of Ceiling at the Laib. <sup>Wale</sup> Below to examine Timbers, the same Planks replaced and additionally the <sup>Wale</sup> Bolted; several started Treennails renewed.

From decay. A new Stenson Knee extending well upon the Main Keelson, the defective part of the latter cut away and made good by the former. The two lower Breast Hoops in way of Stenson taken off and refitted, and a new Fore Piece of Main Keelson
